 - ❖ Each entry must be labeled with name, home phone number, address, parent's e-mail address, grade, school and brief description or title.
- 5. **Judging criteria:** All entries will be judged by professional artists and will be based on originality, representation and relevance to the theme. All decisions are final.
- 6. Categories: K 5th grades; 6th 8th grades; 9th 12th grades.
